OPTIONS TO GET TO/FROM CUA:

- ➤ By metro: Free metro shuttle buses (coaches or regular metro buses) replace trains between NOMA and Fort Totten during the EIC meeting. Listed below are three options and approximate travel times for taking the metro shuttle to CUA. Please refer to the metro system map for the most convenient option. The CUA shuttle stop is at the bus bay (https://www.wmata.com/rider-guide/stations/brookland.cfm). Use the underpass behind the green structure to get to the CUA side. Underpass is open even though no trains are running. Metro staff wearing WMATA operations vests are available for questions at all stations.
 - 1) Local shuttle from NOMA (30-40 min): intermediate stop at Rhode Island Ave. Board the shuttle to the right outside the station, in front of Courtyard Marriott, or follow signs. The bus is likely labeled "Academy" and will make stops at Rhode Island Ave, CUA/Brookland, and Fort Totten.
 - 2) Express shuttle from Union Station (~20 min): follow signs to shuttle stop, located on or near North Capitol St.
 - 3) Express or local shuttle from Fort Totten (~10 min): direct to CUA, board the shuttle to the right outside of the metro station

When getting off at Brookland, walk towards the station (https://www.wmata.com/rider-guide/stations/brookland.cfm). There will be signs saying that the station is closed, but the escalator/underpass is open. Use the underpass to get to the CUA side, cross John McCormack Dr and enter the CUA site. - **By Uber/Lyft:** Can take Uber/Lyft to campus- on iPhone/Android application, for destination enter "Caldwell Hall at CUA". Brings you to the side facing opposite to Leahy Hall (refer to map of Caldwell hall).
- > By car: If coming by car, limited parking space for EICUG is available in the parking garage attached to the CUA Columbus School of Law (3600 John McCormack Dr NE). Can input "Columbus School of Law" on Google maps. Refer to CUA Campus Map for exact location of parking garage. It is facing west of Columbus School of Law when coming from Michigan Ave NE → John McCormack Dr NE.
